## Practical information

### Travelling to Estonia

Participants should arrive to Elva ([https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Elva,\\_Estonia](https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Elva,_Estonia)); (<http://elva.kovtp.ee/web/eng/generalinfo>)

It is possible to fly directly **from Helsinki to Tartu** (<http://www.tartu-airport.ee/eng>). Arriving **from other countries/cities**, you can take a flight to Tallinn Airport (<http://www.tallinn-airport.ee/en/>) or you can come by ship. Information about the passenger ship schedules can be found here: <http://www.portoftallinn.com/passenger-ship-schedules>

**Arriving to Tallinn Airport:** from the airport you have to take the buss to Tartu, at the airport you have possibility to buy the ticket from the machine or you can buy the ticket online (<https://www.tpilet.ee/en>).

**Arriving to Port of Tallinn:** it is closest to take a walking or taxi to Balti Jaam and there you can take a train, schedule can be found online: <http://elron.ee/en/>

Anyway you have to arrive first to Tartu and from there you have to take a bus from the bus station (or depending on your arriving schedule you can take also the train) to Elva. The ticket usually costs 1,60 € or 1,65 €, for some buses 2 €. You can buy tickets from the bus driver.
