- By flight to Vilnius, and then a train to Kaunas
- By flight to Kaunas airport (right now there are not many connections with the countries around the Baltic Sea, except for Norway, Denmark)
- If you take a flight to Vilnius, then you have to take a train from the airport to the Vilnius central train station, and then from the central train station to Kaunas central train station (about 1h - 1.5 h) which is practically in the city centre;
