

## SAFE CITIES COMMISSION ACTION PLAN FOR PERIOD 2017 - 2018

UBC Safe Cities Commission will continue the policy of activities from previous plan and involve new activities.

The main area of interest during two years will be:

- To expand partnership and collaborations of organizations which are responsible for safety promotion in the cities by creating collaboration tools;
- To disseminate knowledge about the safety of young people through their education in the schools, promote appropriate lawful behavior;
- To continue cooperation with other organizations and institutions i.e. Council of the Baltic sea States (CBSS), European Forum for Urban Security (EFUS), other UBC Commissions. The experience of these organizations with EU projects about safety and security may bring to the Commission good ideas and solutions on EU co-financed projects;
- To promote safety issues among community members using modern media and other coordinated activities in local communities of the Commission member cities;
- Prepare and participate in projects regarding safety issues;
- Continue to involve safety specialists from more fields regarding safety issues.

During the period of 2017-2018 Safe Cities Commission plans to organize at least two meetings/seminars each year.

UBC Safe Cities Commission will cooperate with UBC Working group on Gender equality and include gender equality issues in our working agenda.

## **MAIN OBJECTIVES OF ACTION UNTIL 2018**

Implementing projects on opportunities and areas of cooperation with the private sector in terms of maintaining law and order in the cities. Participate at least as a partner in projects regarding safety and civil protection.
