Currently cities are in need to reconsider their strategies for urban planning - searching for new forms and functions for green areas.

Gdynia is situated along Gdansk Bay, the part of the Baltic Sea sheltered by the Hel Peninsula. It's in close vicinity to two other towns, Gdansk and Sopot, which together form an Tricity agglomeration - the core of a metropolitan area.

Gdynia is one of the youngest Polish cities with about 245 000 inhabitants.

Green areas are important part of the city - forests constitute almost 50% of the total area of Gdynia.

You can get to Gdynia by air:

from Malmo, Stockholm Skavsta, Turku, Hambura Lubeck, Goteborg (for more information check on wizzair.com)

from Stockholm Arlanda, Copenhagen, Helsinki (for more information check on norwegian.com)

In addition to the low-cost airlines, flights are also offered from various destinations by Polish airlines lot.com and Scandinavian sas.com.

From airport in Gdansk to the city center of Gdynia:

Train of Pomeranian Metropolitan Railway (polish PKM - Pomorska Kolei Metropolitalna) is located next to airport. Train goes every hour and reaches the Main Railway Station ("Gdynia Główna" station) in approximately 25 minutes.

NEIGHBORHOOD OF "POLANKA REDŁOWSKA" IS LOCATED IN UNIQUE ENVIRONMENT - A DIRECT VIEW OF THE GDAŃSKA BAY, THE SURROUNDING FOREST AREAS AND NATURE RESERVE "KEPA REDŁOWSKA".

IMPORTANT PART OF "POLANKA REDŁOWSKA" IS FORMER SWIMMING POOLS COMPLEX FROM 1950'S, DEMOLISHED IN THE 1990'S. NOW THIS AREA REMAINS UNDEVELOPED AND CITY AUTHORITIES ARE OPEN FOR NEW IDEAS FOR THIS PART OF GDYNIA.

THE AREA ALONG EJSMONDA STREET IS FORMER CITY STADIUM OF ARKA TEAM - ICONIC PLACE FOR ALL FANS OF NOW 90 YEARS OLD ARKA GDYNIA FOOTBALL TEAM. THE STADIUM WAS RELOCATED TO THE NEW LOCATION AND NOW AREA SERVES ARKA GDYNIA TENNIS CLUB.

CURRENTLY IN GDYNIA THERE ARE 2 LARGE PROJECTS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF RECREATIONAL AREAS - CENTRAL PARK AND KAMIENNA GÓRA PARK.

CENTRAL PARK IS LOCATED ALONG THE HISTORICAL COMPOSITE AXIS OF THE CITY (PIŁUSUDSKIEGO AVENUE). NOW IT IS A GREEN AREA WITH NEGLECTED SPORT AREAS. THE ASSUMPTION OF THE PROJECT IS TO CREATE MODERN CITY PARK WITH NEW GREEN AREAS, RECREATIONAL AREAS FOR DIFFRENT GROUP OF RECIPIENTS.

KAMIENNA GÓRA PARK IS LOCATED AROUND THE HIGHEST MOUNTAIN IN THE CITY CENTER. THE ASSUMPTION OF THE PROJECT IS TO REBUILT AND RENEWAL OF THE TERRAIN. THERE WILL BE BUILD NEW ELEVATOR, PUBLIC SCENE AND SMALL ARCHITECTURE OBJECTS - ALL THAT WILL BE COMPELEMENTED WITH NEW GREEN AREAS.

DESIGN TASK FOR THE ENTIRE GROUP IS TO MAKE A PATTERN OF THE URBAN OPEN GREEN AREAS. SMALLER GROUPS GIVE IDEAS FOR ONE OF FIVE LOCATIONS AND A PART OF THE GROUP COORDINATES THE IDEAS OF ENTIRE GROUPS.
