ACTION PLAN 2014

In 2014 Commission on Transportation will deal with transport-related issues connected with public transport, cycling, mobility management as well as with road safety. The planned activities include:

- presenting articles on road safety in the Baltic Cities Bulletin,
- presenting articles on sustainable urban mobility plans in the Baltic Cities Bulletin, Baltic Cities Environmental Bulletin and on the website of the BSR Competence Centre.
- supporting the University of Gdańsk and the City of Gdynia in establishing and maintaining the BSR Competence Centre according to the action plan on BSR Competence Centre elaborated within the Civitas Dyn@mo project,
- support for the initiative of organising a seminar on the development of ports situated in the vicinity of the Natura 2000 network of protected areas (within the Transport Week Conference in Gdańsk) March 2014,
- Joint Commissions meeting (Commissions on Environment, Energy, Urban Planning and Transportation) Örebro, May 2014,
- Commission on Transportation Conference on Sustainable Urban Mobility Plans connected with the Annual Meeting of the Commission on Transportation Gdynia, October 2014,
- support for the abc.multimodal project whose aim is to integrate cycling into multimodal transport system and mobility culture (Commission on Transportation is an associated partner in the project) dissemination activities,
- support for ELMOS project Union of the Baltic Cities is an associated organisation within the ELMOS project: Introducing electric mobility as intermodal transport mean in small and medium sized cities in the South Baltic Area dissemination activities,
- support for the project CIVITAS DYN@MO: within the project Gdynia will work to extend its activities in important fields of sustainable urban transport and focus on three themes: Sustainable urban mobility planning, clean and energy efficient vehicles, intelligent transport systems and Information and Communication Technologies and Intelligent Transport Systems (ICT & ITS) dissemination activities,
- establishing cooperation with new partners, like Polish Union of Active Mobility (PUMA),
- assistance with preparation and realisation of transport projects, which will ask for support in 2014
- updating the website of the TransCom as an information source for the Commission members.
