- Open Commission meetings will continue twice a year focusing every time on one area of the youth work, cities will present their practices and suggestions or conclusions made will be as outcome presented later on the web-page. There will be more focus on promoting youth policy, strategy issues in region but also more focus on activating new cities in countries which have been less involved: Finland, Poland, Lithuania; Germany.
- New project(s) will be started during this period – one focusing on camping and training activities for youth and youth workers and another focusing on introducing youth opinions in Baltic Sea Region gathered during the conferences, promoting dialogue between youth and decision makers and at the same time introducing Commission work and youth work in Baltic Sea Region in general.

- Cooperation with other Commissions and other organizations. Possibly holding joint competitions for young people in partner cities in different areas (photo, literature etc).
- Search for the new vice chair for the Commission.
