Invitation to the XV UBC General Conference, Kaunas, Lithuania, 15-18 October 2019
BUILDING AN INCLUSIVE AND RESIDENT-FOCUSED CITY. THE BALTIC WAY.

Dear Mayors and Member City representatives,

You are cordially invited to attend the General Conference of the UBC which will be organized in Kaunas, Lithuania, on 15-18 October, 2019. The main working days will be 16 and 17 October. The General Conference will be devoted to the topics: "Inclusive Cities" and "Culture as the Catalyst for Cities' Development".

In the recent years the questions how to encourage the citizens to be active in decision-making, how to include them in the social and cultural activities, to be resilient to various social and political processes going on in their societies and neighbourhoods, have been the questions very often asked at different political levels. General Assembly on 17 October, 2019

The General Assembly of the UBC will take place on October 17, in the afternoon. The General Assembly shall, inter alia, elect the Presidium, consisting of the President and three Vice-Presidents, the Executive Board member cities for a two-year period, the Board of Audit members for a two-year period and Secretariat location for a four-year period.

Member Cities wishing to nominate candidates for the posts of President, 1st Vice-President and two Vice-Presidents shall do it in written and signed by the Mayor or other official representative of a Member City. Nominations of cities to the Executive Board should be submitted officially by each country.

All proposals (Presidium, Executive Board, Board of Audit, Secretariat) should be sent to the Union Secretariat in Gdańsk by **15 September 2019**.
