Justification

In October 2009 Gdańsk Municipal Guard conducted a survey among UBC cities. The objective was to identify main problems concerning safety and order in urban areas of the Baltic region. Relatively high level of participation and positive feedback indicated a necessity for cooperation.

In December 2009 results of the survey were published and distributed amongst UBC members together with the invitation for the future collaboration.

In March 2010 representatives of nine cities participated in working group summit in Gdańsk.

Therefore

Group members request for establishing a Task Force within Union of the Baltic Cities which would focus on cooperation in the field of public order and local safety.

The Task Force group would consist of the Chairman, two Vice-Chairmen and the Secretariat. The budget of the Task Force would be constructed in the same way as the Commission within the organization of UBC.




