

SAFE CITIES COMMISSION ACTION PLAN FOR PERIOD 2020

UBC Safe Cities Commission will continue the policy of activities from previous plan and involve new activities.

The main area of interest for the 2020 will be:

- To expand partnership and collaborations of organizations which are responsible for safety promotion (including civil protection) in the cities;
- To disseminate knowledge about the safety of young people through their education in the schools, promote appropriate lawful behavior;
- To continue cooperation with other organizations and institutions i.e. Council of the Baltic sea States (CBSS), European Forum for Urban Security (EFUS), other UBC Commissions. The experience of these organizations with EU projects about safety and security may bring to the Commission good ideas and solutions on EU co-financed projects;
- To promote safety issues among community members using modern media and other coordinated activities in local communities of the Commission member cities;
- Prepare and participate in projects regarding safety issues;
- Continue to involve safety specialists from more fields regarding safety issues;
- Include climate change in the meeting agendas.

In the year 2020 UBC Safe Cities Commission plans to organize at least two meetings/seminars.

Ongoing projects:

- CASCADE – Community Safety Action for Supporting Climate Adaptation and Development (DG ECHO);
- Youth for safer youth (CBSS PSF);
- ReSit – Situational Picture of Volunteerism for Societal Resilience in the Baltic Sea Region (Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Finland).

Projects in preparation:

- NEEDS - Needs-based education and studies in societal security (Erasmus+);
- Youth safety education (based on project “Youth for safer youth” outcomes, funding instrument unknown at the moment).
