# Task Force on Supporting Youth Employment and Well-Being:

## **Action Plan and Budget 2022**

#### **Action Plan 2022**

During the year 2022 Task Force will concentrate on three major themes, which will be as follows:

- STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, Math) Path for every child and youngster
- Basic Skills or Upgrading Pathways (youngsters with problems with basic skills, such as math, literacy, IT)
- Early school leaving and school attendance problems (focus will not be only on the drop-outs after the basic education and during the secondary level education but also on the school attendance problems during the earlier stage of basic education)

Concentrating on certain themes makes cooperation and creation of common goals and projects easier.

#### **Activities**

Activities plan is based on the belief that during the next year we can arrange live study visits. If this won't be the case, we adjust the plans accordingly.

- 3-4 webinars (each webinar will cover 1-2 of the themes mentioned above), estimation of participants in each webinar: 20-40 (altogether 100-120)
- 2 study visits (themes: STEAM and Basic Skills / SAP), estimation of participants: 30
- Eduldu Conference in Tallinn (includes all themes mentioned above)
- planning of new transnational projects in themes mentioned above
- implementation of two General Conference workshops (STEAM and More inclusive VET)
- development of the web-site www.s2wflagship.eu
- continuing the dissemination of good practices
- cooperation with other networks, for example, Flagship School to Work and StartNet
- planning meetings (webinars, study visit, conference, other activities)
- reporting and further planning (2022)
