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Background

City of Turku has agreed to take responsibility of coordinating two Knowledge Platforms under the EUBSR Flagship School to Work:

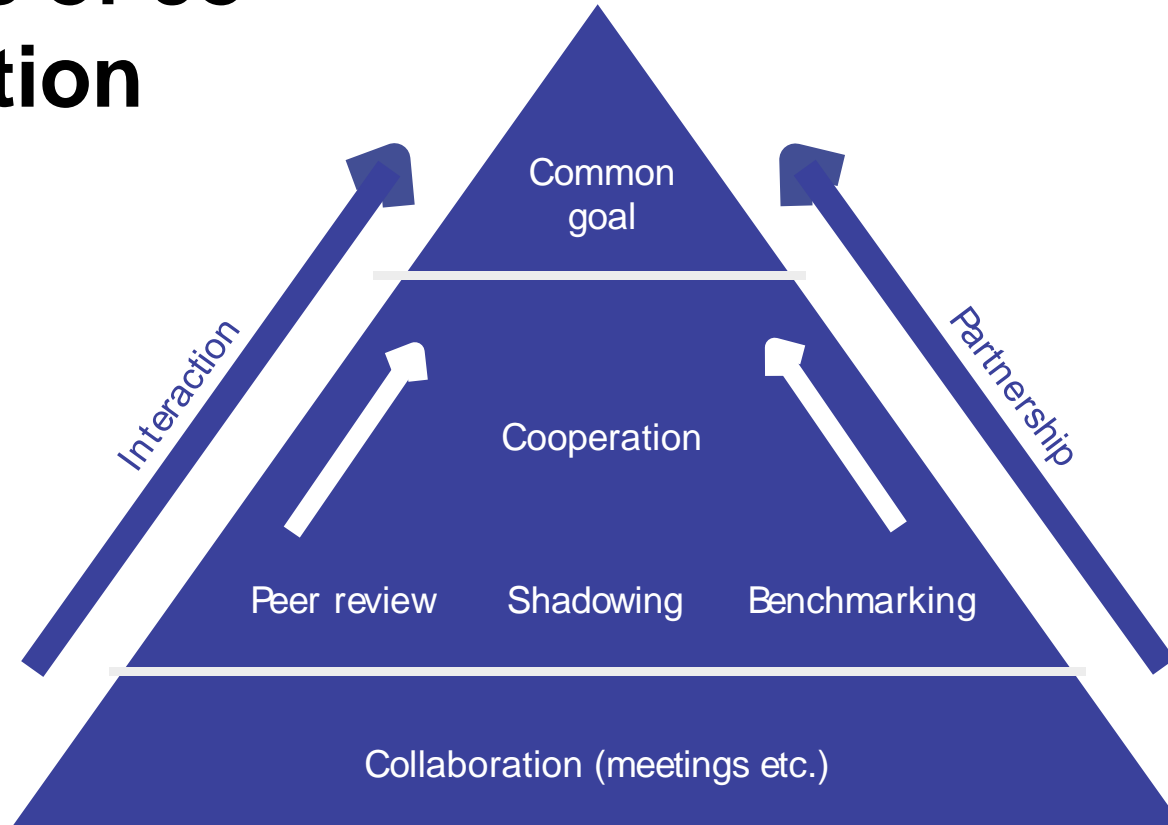
- Early School Leavers
- Refugees

Flagship's goals are parallel to the goals of UBC Task Force on Youth Employment and UBC Board decided in Kristiansand meeting (February 2017) that TF and Flagship should co-operate and use joint resources.

How it works

- Knowledge Platforms offer two kind of services: Support and Development
- Support includes tools, materials, analyses and data, clinics and trainings
- Development includes study visits, collections of good practices, peer evaluation, peer development and new projects
- Knowledge Platforms will be open in August

Activities: spring 2017

- April: study visit to Hamburg; 25 participants from Finland, Sweden, Estonia, Norway and Poland (themes: guidance and mentoring, refugees)
- May: Study visit to Turku, 35 principles, teachers and guidance personnel (theme: Finnish education system)
- June: BS Annual Forum in Berlin (youth guarantee workshop)
- June: Flagship's Kick-off seminar in Stockholm

Plan: autumn 2017

- October: BSR State of the Youth Guarantee Workshop (Växjö, UBC General Conference)
- November / December: Study visit and workshop in Turku (refugees, one-stop-shops, vocational education)
- November: Seminar in Tartu (youth guarantee)
- Planning of other new projects and other forms of co-operation
- Dissemination and marketing of Knowledge Platforms (including collection and dissemination of the best practices)
