### Action Plan 2022<sup>1</sup>

Youthful Cities Commission of the UBC will continue its activities aiming at empowering youth participation in the BSR and best practice exchange between member cities in the field of youth:

- Finalising debate on format and further operations of Youthful Cities Commission (final decisions to be made during the nearest physical meeting of the Commission)
- Showcasing cities' best practices and success stories in the field of youth work and youth participation (utilizing online tools and social media)
- Supporting development of bilateral and multilateral projects among the member cities of the Commission (online project development workshop to be held in January)
- Sustaining Baltic Sea Youth Platform:
  - promoting Erasmus+ project's results and their use by the UBC member cities and their youth
  - participating in discussion about Platform's format and operations after the end of the project's budget
  - encouraging youth dimension in key BSR events

Meetings of the Commission in 2022:

- at least 2 meetings (indicatively in April and October, at least one of them – a face-to-face meeting)

Project work:

- Erasmus+ project “Baltic Sea Youth Platform” (to be prolonged until December 2022)
- Erasmus+ project “YUPAD – YoUth Participatory budgets empowering young people using big Data” (to be started in 2022, if the project is approved)
