Working Title	Neighborly self-help - a micro solution to macro problems
Context summary	Kindness and neighborly help seem to be an element of basic social relations. For many people, neighbors are the ones who are able to help and support. This is especially appreciated by older and sick people who sometimes struggle with even basic things and require some form of support. From 2023, neighborhood help has become a social service in Poland, which can also be provided for a fee. This concept includes help provided in various forms (basic hygiene and nursing care, assistance in meeting basic life needs, meeting the needs for contact with the social environment).
General objective of the project	Developing and transferring different solutions in area of elderly support, mainly in services held in close surroundings of person, such as neighbourhood self-help
