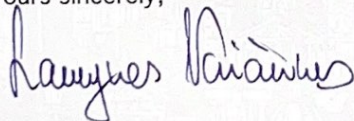
Dear Sir or Madam,

Jan Nowak-Jeziorański College of Eastern Europe in cooperation with the Union of the Baltic Cities is honoured to invite Your City to participate in the newly launched project called **Euro-Atlantic *dominion Maris Baltici*. Multidimensional security in the Baltic Sea basin. Expert, civil and (local) government perspectives.** The project's aim is to intensify regional cooperation in the field of security in both hard and soft measures by exchanging information, know-how, best practices and, hopefully, creating new, unconventional forms of cooperation.

We propose to organise a **first Baltic Round Table** on hard and soft security. The initial event could be held in **Gdańsk** in **late autumn 2026**. Whether the Baltic cities, including Yours, decide to join the initiative, the Baltic Roundtables could be held annually in various Baltic cities. The initiative would bring together around 25-30 security experts, including former and active military personnel, representatives of local governments, state institutions, diplomats and non-governmental organizations from Poland, the Baltic and Nordic states and Ukraine.
